Henry Gunter 1920-2007

Henry was born in Jamaica and studied accountancy before living and working in Panama and the United States. After becoming interested in trade unionism he set up his own newspaper, the Jamaican Worker. He came to Birmingham in 1949 joining the Afro-Caribbean Organisation, becoming its Chairman c.1954. Continuing his work against racism, he organised a demonstration against the 'colour bar' in the city in 1952.
