be my executors and I direct that

testamentary expensess shall be paid
as soon as possible after my decease.
I hereby give Bequests unto my

Real and Personal property
or Estate whatsoever and wheresoever
to which I am or may become
entitled to. I do this in recognition

she has rendered to me for so
