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	Wathan Waller to his son Thomas Wathen Waller, following the death of George IV	Page number (if known):	

Hale Sunday July 4 1830.

Many thanks my dearest Boy for your Letter of the 27th. Believe me I feel to the Soul, all your Expression of warm Attachment to myself & my Heart responds fondly to it; but there is a part of your Letter my Child of such vital Importance to your best Interests, that I must at once turn my Pen to it. You say "I am young & "my Mood is too much naturally given "to Enquiry on every subject that presents "itself, to allow my Opinion to be firmly & "steadily formed". Now my beloved Boy this is the Rock in your Character I chiefly dread, & if not under divine Guidance may I fear, lead you to the Pit of Infidelity & eternal misery. It too often terminates in that Pride of human Intellect, which judging only by fallable Reason made the Jews reject their Saviour & led him to tell them, "that Harlots & Adulterer would enter the Kingdom of Heaven before them." The Saviour's Instructions to

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Enquiries are these, "Search the Scriptures" & again Blessed are they who <u>see not</u> & <u>yet believe</u>." There is but <u>one</u> God & <u>one</u> Volume of <u>Truth</u>. To that standard <u>all</u> must be brought & that which agreeth not <u>there unto</u> must be <u>rejected</u> as the Refuge of <u>Lies</u> &

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the work of Satan. The Spirit of Enquiry, within these Limits will lead to immortal Happenings , beyond, only to the Exaltation of human Intellect, & is the great Enemy of Truth & the mighty Engine of the Evil one. The Religion of God from the Creation was a Religion of Faith. In the primeval Ages, it pointed to a promised Redeemer & was typified by Sacrifice. In the next a Jewish Dispensation, this was still more specifically marked, & in the Christian it is fully revealed, & all these Types being accomplished in the Birth Life, Death, Resurrection & Assension of Christ, we are now called upon to place our Faith in a crucified Redeemer, & one laughs that this Faith

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can only be obtained from the Study of this Scripture he has left behind, & by that Spirit, he has promised to every one that sincerely & earnestly seeks it from him. Beyond this Limmit, however Enquiry leads but to Error, for until a Worm; the finite Creature of a short Day, can comprehend, all the Action & Mind, of his infinite Creator & God he must confine his Enquiries, to the Boundary of Revelation, & of the Revelation only which Incomprehensibility affords him: & at the Feet of Faith. he must lay down the Pride of Reason & humbly submitting himself, he must adore & hope for clearer manifestation, when this corruptible shall have had on Incorruption & this Mortal -Immortality; since till he can explain how a grain of Corn becomes an Ear of wheat. & after an apparent death and state of Inaction even for a Century, with, on being sown, still produce its peculiar & distinct Blade; how can he expect to understand, & explain, what the Almightly has not been pleased to reveal. Abel in humble Faith offered his Sacrifice by shedding of Blood

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us commanded from the first as a Type of a future Redeemer < and was accepted >, but proud Cain, thought for himself & rejecting Revelation brought his Corn without Blood, & was both himself & his Posterity rejected by God. 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the <u>will</u> of his heavenly Father, & you would prostrate <u>yourself</u> at the Throne of Grace, & exclaim, 'Lord I <u>believe</u> help then mine <u>Unbelief</u>. Thou art just & righteous & merciful, T<u>hy</u> will not <u>mine</u> be done !!!

I will no longer sermonize my beloved Boy, but at this moment the vast & superior Importance of heavenly to earthly things, is so deeply empressed in my Heart, by the awful Lesson I have learned, that I trust it will never more be absent from my mind, & as your <u>Parent</u> & your <u>Friend</u>, I cannot resist the Wish & Hope of impressing these Truths on <u>your</u> mind, not yet hardened by Passion, Example or Pride of Intellect to the Truth. You live in a Circean Circle of Infidelity Dissipation & Error. Reject not my Child in that Circle, these Principles early implanted in your Mind, & amidst your other <u>necessary</u> Studies, neglect not the <u>Study</u> of that <u>sacred Volume</u> which can alone enlighten your understanding

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for another World & reject all your Heart & Actions in this -I have little to tell you. The Queens Establishment is settled & declared, but until after the Funeral the King considers himself only as Duke of Clarence, & as such, will attend the Ceremony, & will not name a single Person except (as Knighton has resigned) he was obliged to appoint a Privy Purse, in Col now Gen.¹ Wheatley. To my sorrow he insists on my Presence & being near to his Person. I would gladly have spared my Heart the Pang, but it is my duty & I submit -Anna means to write & will tell you all domestic news.
