which time I think I shall be able to do trench duty again as Therapia is a particularly healthy place for you always get the sea breeze & sea bathing every morning although like all the places along the Bosphorus this hot weather there is nothing to do except read smoke & eat melons which are very acceptable when one is thirsty especially the water melons for they
