I will tell you that all the money I have had or could raise has been employd to enable my poor sisters family to wait for the arrangements which are to take place

Besides the original 400£ I owe you a years interest at least, and 100 at least more for the attendance of last year. I shall I hope be able this very next week to pay you 120 - & I then propose
